Elements of the Conversation	Facts, anecdotes, and mini-life dramas strung into a chronological STORY of my adventure, loss, gain, joy, happiness, pain, and sorrow.	Self-image. Influences my feelings and my actions and forms how I act. Integrated self-identity with primary identity—who I am in Christ. Spiritual gifts identification.	Extrapolation (a method to understand the unknown by using the known). “What does this mean, Lord?” why have you, God, created me to be who I am? What does that look like?	Interpretation. Spiritual role identification. i.e. (shepherd, teacher, prophet, leading, apostle)	Application, mobilization. “God, what is my role in your Kingdom?	Focus, vision, goals, objectives, accountabilities, steps, outcomes, and impact.
